- 1. We see ourselves as scouts and we live by our rules.
 - We want to give up the open use of unnecessary technology. This applies especially to mobile phones and flashlights.
 - We want to be recognized on the camp and in public as scouts and leave a positive image to visitors (press, politics), the person in charge of the place and the residents around the camp.
- 2. We note the Youth Protection Act and the rules of the place.
 - Smoking is permitted in special smoking areas only over 18 years old people.
 - Alcohol is over 16, can only be obtained from the café and consumed only there. The rules of the cafes and the instructions of the café teams must be obeyed!
 - Fireplaces may only be set up on a base of gravel or in a fire pit. Outside of tents (e.g. promise celebrations) they must be registered in the info yurt. Fire water and supervision must always be given.
 - The surrounding forest and the surrounding fields may not be accessed. In particular, Wood shall not be beaten there. Wood for fires and tents will be provided by us in sufficient quantity!
 - Holes and drainage ditches are to be avoided! The resulted sods are handled with care and at the end of the camp neat reinsertion.
 - Bicycle and car driving is forbidden on the campsite.
 - The swimming pool is allowed to enter and to be used only at the opening times. The rules of the swimming pool and the instructions of the staff must be obeyed!
 - Animals must be registered and always on the leash!

- 3. We all have a shared responsibility to have a nice and wonderful camp for all.
 - You are (especially as group leaders) responsible for your participants and to motivate them to attend in the program, and are of course even welcome! Important to us above all are punctuality and reliability. Scouts and cubs (under 14) need a support by group leaders at the program.
 - For the happening of the camp we need capable helpers inside the program and services for the technical team.
 - Please register your daily visitors in the info yurt.
- 4. We respect each other on our well-being.
 - Always wear sturdy shoes on the camping ground!
 - Please be sure to treat your material carefully, so that no one hurt. This applies not only saws and hatchets, which should not lying around open, but also unattended fuel, fire or gas lamps.
 - In the kitchen and in the bathroom please use hand sanitizer. Especially in the kitchen hygiene is important!
 - Please collect and separate your garbage.
 - For each cooking fire you need a fire blanket! For each hearth fire water (stirrup pump or bucket of water)! ABC fire extinguishers are rather unfavourable.
